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IMPORTANT MESSAGE REGARDING U.I. BENEFITS PAID (UC-1099G TAX FORMS)

Effective January 1, 2017 The CT Department of Labor will no longer mail hardcopies of form 1099G. Printable electronic copies are available online.

The UC-1099G tax form (Statement of Unemployment Compensation Payments) is now available online for calendar years 2012-2016. To better secure your information, a login page is now in use. If you've already used our online account system to file weekly (continued) claims, perform account status inquiries, or manage your receipt of benefits via direct deposit or debit card, you must enter the same User ID and Password that you've used to access those features in order to access your tax information. If you don't already have a user ID and Password or you've forgotten your User ID or Password, you can click on the "Create an Account/Forgot User ID or Password" link.

Please be advised that you are mandated by federal and state law to provide your social security number to the Connecticut Department of Labor for use in the administration of the Unemployment Insurance program. The specific legal authorities for requiring your social security number are 42 U.S.C §1320b-7 and sections 31-222-13(d)(1) and (4) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies. In addition, because section 31-235 of the Connecticut General Statutes requires registration with the Employment Service as a condition of continuing eligibility for unemployment benefits, your social security number will also be used in the administration of the Employment Service program.

Important Tax Information

Notice to Recipient: The Revenue Act of 1978 requires the Connecticut Department of Labor to report the unemployment compensation payments of \$10 or more on Form UC-1099G.

Please Note:

- Copy A has been filed electronically with the Internal Revenue Service.
- Copy B is for your records.
- Copy C is potentially for state income tax purposes. Check your filing instructions.

Item 2 on this form shows the total unemployment compensation paid to you in 2016 by the Department of Labor. This represents taxable income to you.

"This is important tax information and is being furnished to the Internal Revenue Service. If you are required to file a return, a negligence penalty or other sanction may be imposed on you if this income is taxable and the IRS determines that it has not been reported."

Item 3 on this form represents the amount repaid in this tax year towards an unemployment compensation overpayment. This includes cash repayments, intercepted income tax refunds and/or amounts offset from unemployment compensation payments.

CT Public Act number 96-206 provides for voluntary withholding of Federal (10%) and State (3%) taxes. Items 4 and 5 show the total amount of income tax withheld in 2016. The Internal Revenue Service and Connecticut Department of Revenue Services have been furnished the same information.

EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT DON'T SHORTCHANGE YOUR FAMILY

You may qualify for up to \$6,269 of EITC in 2016 if:

- You earned income from wages and had at least one child living with you for more than half the year. Your income must have been less than \$53,505 (with three or more children); less than \$50,198 (with two children); or \$44,846 (with one child)

OR

- You did not have a qualifying child, earned less than \$20,430, were at least age 25 but under 65, and were not someone's dependent.

If you qualify for the tax credit, it will reduce the amount of federal tax owed to the IRS. If you owe no federal income tax, you will receive the credit in the form of a refund. Get more information by calling the IRS at 1-800-829-3676 and ask for free Publication 596, Earned Income Credit.
