CNC Programmer/Operator, Wallingford (Job ID 242196) The CNC Programmer is responsible for developing software programs that direct CNC (computer numerically controlled) machines to cut and shape a variety of materials (primarily metals) to produce components and other industrial machined parts and tools utilized in the aerospace industry. In addition to programming responsibilities, the position also has responsibility for some level of operation of CNC and other machines as required.

CNC Machinist, Wallingford (Job ID 242195) A CNC machinist produces machined parts by programming, setting up, and operating a computer numerical control (CNC) machine; maintaining quality and safety standards; keeping records; maintaining equipment and supplies. Plans machining by studying work orders, blueprints, engineering plans, materials, specifications, orthographic drawings, reference planes, locations of surfaces, and machining parameters; interpreting geometric dimensions and tolerances (GD&T).

Quality Inspector, Wallingford (Job ID 242194) Approves in-process and finished products by confirming specifications; conducting visual and measurement tests and then returning products for re-work; confirming re-work. Working from purchase orders, special process certifications, operation sheets, blueprints, and other specifications, ensures that all parts and materials are in full compliance.

CNC Operator, (Computer Numeric Control Operator), Wallingford (Job ID 242199) Produces machined parts by programming, setting up, and operating a computer numerical control (CNC) machine; maintaining quality and safety standards; keeping records; maintaining equipment and supplies.
