JOB INFORMATION AND REQUIREMENTS

Homemakers – Candidates should have 6 months’ experience, \$10.10+ hourly, full time, and rotating shifts. Assist the elderly, convalescents, or persons with disabilities with daily living activities at the person's home or in a care facility. Duties include making beds, doing laundry, washing dishes and preparing meals. May provide assistance at non-residential care facilities. Advise on nutrition, cleanliness, and household activities.

Direct Care Workers – (Home Health Aides, Personal Care Aides and Certified Nursing Aides). Candidates should have two months’ experience. \$10.10+ hourly, rotating shifts, Full Time. Assist the elderly, convalescents, or persons with disabilities with daily living activities at the person's home or in a care facility. Duties include keeping house (making beds, doing laundry, washing dishes) and preparing meals. May provide assistance at non-residential care facilities.

Companions –Candidates should have six months’ experience, \$10.10+ hourly, full time, and rotating shifts. Provide routine individualized healthcare such as changing bandages and dressing wounds, and applying topical medications to the elderly, convalescents, or persons with disabilities at the patient's home or in a care facility. Monitor or report changes in health status. May also provide personal care such as bathing, dressing, and grooming of patient.

Bilingual Personal Care Assistant – Duties include bathing/showering/dressing, eating/feeding, grooming, mobility/walking, toileting/bowel and bladder care. Candidates should have reliable transportation, excellent communication skills, and a love and passion for what you do. One year caregiver experience required. Bilingual English/Spanish required.
