# Reminder: *Diverse Ability* Career Fair is Oct. 29 At Waterbury's Courtyard by Marriott

WETHERSFIELD, October 28, 2015 – More than 35 employers will be on hand to meet with jobseekers and discuss employment opportunities during a *Diverse Ability* Career Fair being held October 29 at the Courtyard by Marriot, located at 63 Grand Street, Waterbury.

Titled “Build a Diverse Workforce – Boost Your Bottom Line,” the free event, which runs from 11 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., is a career fair for jobseekers looking for employment opportunities, as well as a resource fair for employers interested in learning about recruitment and training resources, and available support services when hiring employees with disabilities.
