



More than 40 Employers To Attend Danbury Veterans' Career Fair on June 1

WETHERSFIELD, May 29, 2015 – More than 40 employers will be on hand to meet with former military personnel, their spouses and other family members during a June 1 Veterans' Career Fair being held at the Ethan Allen Hotel, 21 Lake Avenue Extension in Danbury.

The Career Fair, which will run from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m., is sponsored by the Connecticut Department of Labor – a partner in the *American Job Center Network* – Town Square Media, the City of Danbury and the Greater Danbury Chamber of Commerce.

Among the companies exhibiting at the event will be ESPN, Kimberly-Clark Corporation, Mohegan Sun, New York Life, Travelers and Zierick Manufacturing Corporation.

In addition to meeting with employers, attendees can have their résumés reviewed by Certified Professional Résumé Writers from the Connecticut Department of Labor. Agency staff will be on-site throughout the day to critique résumés to ensure that they effectively showcase accomplishments and transferable skills.

A Veterans' Orientation Workshop, offered from 1 to 1:30 p.m. and open to all attendees, is geared toward helping veterans learn more about the many employment services available at the state's *American Job Center* offices. Staff from the Labor Department's Office for Veterans' Workforce Development will be on hand to talk with visitors about career plans and related services.
