



Protection Against Falls in the Workplace Topic At June 16 CONN-OSHA Employer Roundtable

“Andy will deliver a comprehensive overview of the various equipment needed, including body belts and harnesses, shock absorbing technologies, lanyards, self-retracting lanyards, anchors and connectors,” explains John Able, Certified Safety Professional and Breakfast Roundtable Discussion Group project coordinator. “The fall protection demonstration itself will include both a non-shock absorbing lanyard and a shock absorbing lanyard.”
