



Department of Labor's Fall Career Fair Series Offers Cromwell, Danbury, Waterbury Events

WETHERSFIELD, September 9, 2015 – The Connecticut Department of Labor's career fair series returns this month with a fall schedule including events in Cromwell, Danbury and Waterbury. The first, the Middlesex County Career Fair, will be held September 28 from 11:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. at the Crown Plaza in Cromwell, followed by the Danbury Career Fair, taking place 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. October 9 at the Ethan Allen Hotel. Rounding out the schedule is the *Diverse Ability* Career Fair, set for 11 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. October 29 at the Courtyard by Marriott in Waterbury.

"With more than 18 years of experience in providing job and career services to our Connecticut residents, the Labor Department is recognized as a leader in offering effective, well-organized events to help match companies expanding their workforce with quality employees," explains Labor Commissioner Sharon M. Palmer. "Each fall, our career fair series attracts thousands of jobseekers and hundreds of businesses looking to make successful employment connections."

There is no cost for jobseekers to attend these events and parking is convenient and free. All three fairs will include hands-on assistance from Labor Department employees who will help visitors develop and critique their résumés, create Linked In profiles, and register for employment workshops at *American Job Centers*. Visitors can also receive information on finding a new job or changing careers.

Employer registration, which includes an exhibit table, program guide listing, radio, newspaper and Internet advertising and advertisements at *American Job Centers*, veterans' centers, local libraries and community organizations is as follows:

- September 28 Middlesex County Career Fair: \$300
- October 9 Danbury Career Fair: \$475
- October 29 *Diverse Ability* Career Fair: \$200

Employer registration for any of the fairs is an additional \$25 if electricity is required.
