# Labor Department's CONN-OSHA Offers Jan. 9 Powered Industrial Truck Safety Training Workshop

WETHERSFIELD, January 2, 2018 – The Connecticut Department of Labor's Division of Occupational Safety and Health (CONN-OSHA) is offering an Industrial Truck Safety Training workshop from 10 a.m. to noon on January 9 to help operators meet the Occupational Safety and Health Administration's Powered Industrial Truck Standard – 29 CFR 1910.178, which includes formal instruction, practical training, and an evaluation of operator performance. The workshop will be held at the agency's Central Office, 200 Folly Brook Boulevard in Wethersfield.

"There are always hazards associated with operating any type of equipment," explains CONN-OSHA Occupational Safety Training Specialist Catherine Zinsser. "It's important to be aware of the latest information and know the requirements, as it pertains to health and safety, while operating this type of industrial vehicle."
