“Breakfast & Benefits – An Employer’s Guide to Unemployment Insurance” Seminar Is March 29

WETHERSFIELD, February 22, 2018 – Employers often have questions when trying to understand the process used to determine an employee’s eligibility for Unemployment Compensation benefits. A March 29 breakfast seminar sponsored by the Connecticut Employment and Training Commission and the Labor Department’s Office of Workforce Competitiveness is designed to help businesses and organizations handle unemployment benefit procedures more effectively.

Breakfast & Benefits – An Employer’s Guide to Unemployment Insurance will be held 8 to 11 a.m. with check-in and breakfast beginning at 7:30 a.m. The seminar, facilitated by David Ricciuti of the Labor Department’s Office of Program Policy, offers a comprehensive overview on unemployment insurance basics, the eligibility process, and a question and answer session. Topics to be covered include:

- Analysis and guidance to state unemployment insurance laws.
- Cost-effective approaches to managing claims.
- Effectively approving an employee for benefits, whether the separation is voluntary or involuntary
- The importance of an employer’s participation in a benefits determination hearing.
