30th Annual Manchester Community College Regional Job Fair is April 6

WETHERSFIELD, March 1, 2018 – The Manchester Community College Regional Job Fair, the second event in the Connecticut Department of Labor’s 2018 Career Fair series, celebrates a milestone on April 6 -- its 30th anniversary of matching jobseekers with prospective employees.

Taking place from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the college, the job fair is co-sponsored by Manchester Community College, the Connecticut Department of Labor, the MCC Foundation and the Journal Inquirer.

“The Connecticut Department of Labor and Manchester Community College have a longstanding partnership and a history of bringing together jobseekers and prospective employers,” explains State Labor Commissioner Scott Jackson. “While at the Manchester Community College Regional Career Fair, visitors will have the opportunity to meet one-on-one with representatives from 60 companies that are offering positions in management, manufacturing, medical, technical and a variety of other fields.”

The fee for exhibitors is \$350. That includes an eight-foot booth, a six-foot draped table, chairs and booth signage, and a wide range of publicity through local radio and newspaper ads, press releases, community calendar listing and newsletter notifications. Thousands of jobseekers will also be notified through Facebook and Twitter postings, email and the Connecticut Department of Labor’s website. Early registration is encouraged. Admission for jobseekers is free.
