# CONN-OSHA Offers April 12 Workshop On Construction Site Safety and Awareness

WETHERSFIELD, March 15, 2018 – Employees in the Connecticut Department of Labor’s Division of Occupational Safety and Health (CONN-OSHA) will identify four potential hazard areas that every manager, first line supervisor and construction employee should be concerned with during an April 12 construction site safety workshop to be held 9 a.m. to noon in the agency’s Wethersfield office, 200 Folly Brook Boulevard.
