More Than 50 Employers Already Signed Up to Participate in April 4th *Heroes 4 Hire* Career Fair

WETHERSFIELD, March 6, 2018 – More than 50 companies and service organizations have already signed up to participate in the Heroes 4 Hire Career Fair – the largest of its kind in New England. The event will take place at the Pratt and Whitney Stadium Ballroom at Rentschler Field in East Hartford on Wednesday April 4. This veterans-focused event typically attracts more than 600 veterans each year.

Sponsored by the Connecticut Department of Labor, Connecticut Department of Veterans Affairs, Entercom Radio, Pratt & Whitney, and Travelers, the event will be held 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.
