CTDOL Veterans' Staff Taking Part in June 9 Third Annual Veterans' Stand Down *Held at Danielson's Quinebaug Valley Community College*

WETHERSFIELD, June 5, 2018 – Veterans' staff from the Connecticut Department of Labor will be on hand to assist their fellow veterans with job search advice, career assistance and related matters during Quinebaug Community College's third annual Veterans' Stand Down being held 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. June 9 on the school's Danielson campus. The free Saturday event, held in partnership with the Danielson Veterans' Coffeehouse, is open to any veteran.

The Stand Down event is an opportunity to reach out to veterans and their families living in northeast Connecticut. A Labor Department Veterans' Representative will be available to assist visitors needing advice about Unemployment Insurance benefits, seeking information about employment workshops at the *American Job Centers*, or tips on conducting an effective job search.

Attendees also can take advantage of a many other services, including free hearing and eye screening, legal advice, and information on transportation, housing and health issues – all offered by area social service organizations and state agencies.
