CTDOL Partners with Workforce Board, Chamber to Offer June 27 Career Fair

WETHERSFIELD, May 28, 2019 – The Connecticut Department of Labor is partnering with the Greater Danbury Chamber of Commerce and the Northwest Regional Workforce Board to provide a June 27 career fair to be held 5 to 9 p.m. June 27 at the Danbury Fair Mall. The free event is also sponsored by the Danbury Fair Mall and Career Path Mobile.

“The Greater Danbury Career Fair 2019 offers a great venue for employers to interact with prospective job candidates, accept résumés, and talk about their business and job openings,” said State Labor Commissioner Kurt Westby. “Labor Department staff will be available to provide information about jobs posted to our CTHires electronic job bank, and employment services at the American Job Centers, including workshops, résumé assistance and weekly recruitment events.”

There is no fee for employers to participate, and exhibitors receive booth space with a skirted table and two chairs. Employers are welcome to bring signage. As an additional free service, jobseekers can have their headshot taken for use on LinkedIn or job-related sites.
