CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

A petition having been filed with the Connecticut State Board of Labor Relations on November 1, 1945 by International Association of Bridge, Structural and Ornamental Iron Workers, Local #532, A. F. of L., hereinafter called the Union, alleging that a question or controversy existed concerning the representation of employees of New England Iron Works, hereinafter called the Employer, and the Board having duly investigated such question or controversy, and due notice of such investigation and of the filing of said petition having been given to all parties,

AND, it having been agreed and consented to by and between all parties that a public hearing on the said petition be waived and that a question or controversy within the meaning of Section 6 of the Connecticut Labor Relations Act exists concerning the representation of such employees of the Employer, and that the following employees constitute a unit appropriate for the purposes of collective bargaining within the meaning of Section 6 subsection 2, of the Connecticut State Labor Relations Act: Foremen, layout men, blacksmiths, fitters, welders, punch and shear operators, burners and operators of all power machines and helpers (excluding office and executive employees and outside plant men), and that the employer submit to the Board, or its agents, wage receipts or other documents containing the signatures of all such employees, and that the Union submit to the Board, or its agents, cards or other documents containing applications for membership in and/or designating as representative for the purposes of collective bargaining said union, and signed by the said employees, and that if upon comparison of the signatures on said cards or other documents submitted by the Union, with the signatures on said wage receipts or other documents submitted by the Employer, the Board should find that a majority of the said employees had applied for membership in and/or designated as representative for purposes of collective bargaining said Union, then the Board might certify the said organization as exclusive representative of the said employees for purposes of collective bargaining,

AND, such comparison of signatures having been made by the Board or its agent, and it having been found that 11 employees of the 19 eligible employees within the said appropriate unit had applied for membership in and had designated as representative for purposes of collective bargaining said Union and it having been found, after due investigation, that International Association of Bridge, Structural and Ornamental Iron Workers, Local #532, A. F. of L. has been designated and selected by a majority of the employees within said appropriate unit as their representative for the purposes of collective bargaining,

NOW THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Connecticut Board of Labor Relations by Section 6 of the Connecticut State Labor Relations Act, it is hereby

CERTIFIED, that International Association of Bridge, Structural and Ornamental Iron Workers, Local #532, A. F. of L., has been designated and selected as representative for the purposes of collective bargaining by the majority of all employees of New England Iron Works who are foremen, layout men, blacksmiths, fitters, welders, punch and shear operators, burners and operators of all power machines and helpers (but excluding office and executive employees and outside plant men) and that, pursuant to the provisions of Section 6 of the Connecticut state Labor Relations Act, said International Association of Bridge, Structural and Ornamental Iron Workers, Local #532, A. F. of L., is the exclusive representative of all such employees for the purposes of collective bargaining in respect to rates of pay, wages, hours of employment, and other conditions of employment.
