**DECISION AND
EXPANSION OF UNIT**

Pursuant to the Order of Election dated November 4, 2011, an election by secret mail ballot was conducted from November 8, 2011 to November 18, 2011, under the supervision of the Connecticut State Board of Labor Relations. The tally of ballots was as follows:

Copies of the Report Upon Secret Ballot were duly served upon all parties. No exceptions to the report or objections to the election were filed with the Board.

Since the parties have agreed that the unit is appropriate, the Board's approval of the action herein is not to be taken as a precedent as to what unit it would find appropriate in the absence of such an agreement.

Therefore, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Connecticut State Board of Labor Relations by the Municipal Employee Relations Act, it is hereby,

DETERMINED, that the existing unit represented by AFSCME, Council 4, AFL-CIO be, and the same hereby is, expanded to include the positions of Animal Control Officer and Assistant Animal Control Officer, and that said AFSCME, Council 4, AFL-CIO is the exclusive representative of all said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to wages, hours and other conditions of employment.
