**DECISION, DISMISSAL OF PETITION
AND
CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE**

Pursuant to the Agreement for Consent Election dated January 25, 2012, an election by secret ballot was conducted on February 23, 2012 at Monroe, Connecticut, under the supervision of the Connecticut State Board of Labor Relations. The tally of ballots was as follows:

DISMISSAL OF PETITION

Therefore, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Connecticut State Board of Labor Relations by the Municipal Employee Relations Act, it is hereby

ORDERED, that the Petition for Representation filed herein by UPSEU on January 4, 2012, be and the same hereby is dismissed, and further, it is

CERTIFIED, that Local 818 of Council 4, AFSCME, AFL-CIO has been designated as the representative for the purposes of collective bargaining among the employees of the Employer in a unit classified as all supervisory employees of the Town, including the Sanitarian, Highway Foreman, Fire Marshal, Chief Building Official, Deputy Director of Public Works, Adult Services Librarian, Recreation Maintenance Supervisor, Planning Administrator, Accountant, Assessor, Senior Citizen Director, Land Use Coordinator, Executive Assistant to the Police Chief, and Children's Librarian and that Local 818 of Council 4, AFSCME, AFL-CIO is the exclusive representative of all said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to wages, hours and other conditions of employment.
