Pursuant to the Notice of Runoff Election, dated March 7, 2012, a runoff election by secret ballot was conducted on March 20, 2012 at Hamden, Connecticut, under the supervision of the Connecticut State Board of Labor Relations. The tally of ballots was as follows:

CERTIFIED, that United Public Service Employees Union has been selected as the representative for the purposes of collective bargaining by all employees of the Hamden Board of Education in the following classifications: Director of Instructional Technology, Facilities Director, Business Supervisor, Information Technology Specialist, Office Manager/Transportation Supervisor – HHS, Assistant Director of Facilities, Office Manager – HMS, Desktop Support Specialist, Construction/Administration Assistant, Office Assistant - Superintendent and that said United Public Service Employees Union

is the exclusive representative of all said employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with respect to wages, hours and other conditions of employment.
