

## CATV Electronic Technician (Television-Cable Installer) 821.281.010

The following schedule of work experience is intended as a guide; it need not be followed in any particular sequence and it is understood that some adjustments must be necessary in the hours allotted for different work experience. In all cases the apprentice is to receive sufficient experience to become fully competent in all work processes which are a part of the trade. The apprentice will be fully instructed in safety and OSHA requirements.

- A. BASIC COMPANY ORGANIZATION (160 Hours)

- B. BASIC JOB ORIENTATION (1000 Hours)  
(Pole and Ladder Work)
  - 1. Pole climbing
  - 2. First aid
  - 3. Working aloft
  - 4. Electrical hazards
  - 5. Use of ladders
  - 6. Company specifications
  
- C. SPECIFIC JOB TRAINING (4400 Hours)  
(Tools and Equipment)
  - 1. Use, care and maintenance of tools & equipment
  - 2. Use of prints, specifications and practices
  - 3. Adjustments and testing
  - 4. Trouble shooting practices
  - 5. Splicing of cables and equipment
  - 6. Operation of active and passive devices
  - 7. Applications of test equipment
  - 8. Driving and operation of hydraulic ladder
  
- D. RELATED SUPPLEMENTAL INSTRUCTION (440 Hours)  
Related training at a state technical school or approved home study or extension training course to be monitored by the sponsor.
