SUBJECT: Final WIA Performance Outcomes of PY 2013

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Attached are Connecticut's final PY13 performance outcomes for the state and its local areas. Outcomes are used in the determination of incentives/sanctions.

At this time, incentive funding is not available.

Regions who are subject to sanctioning for PY13 will receive notice under a separate cover.

In this issuance of the WIA performance outcomes, we have noted data sources. WIA performance is calculated using the ETA 9090 and 9091 report, produced through the US DOL DRVS reporting tool. The states and other reporting entities submit data extracts to the US DOL Employment and Training Administration (ETA). Use of a single reporting tool by the ETA ensures conformity in calculation.

The DRVS reporting tool produces data in various tables in the ETA 9090 and 9091 report. Tables A-M represents final statewide performance data as accepted by the US DOL ETA. Actual performance for the Common measures is taken from Table B for Adults, Table E for Dislocated Workers and Table H.1 for Youth. Table O data represents final local area performance for all three programs as accepted by US DOL ETA.

Note 1: Local area performance outcomes are determined in Table O. Table O does not provide the numerators and denominators used in the calculation of these outcomes. Divisions of the numerators and denominators in Tables B,E and H.1 of the local report do not necessarily produce the same ratios

reflected in Actual Performance in Table O. Differences in ratios, if any, are a function of programming within the ETA DRVS reporting tool.

Note 2: Adding the WIB numerators and denominators will not necessarily produce the State numerator and denominator. Not all WIB data aligns properly because of data entry issues. These data entry issues do not affect State data.
