## **Labor Department Announces Upcoming Job and Career Fair Series**

WETHERSFIELD, Feb. 7, 2011 – Beginning in March, the Connecticut Department of Labor’s popular Job and Career Fair spring series returns for its 15th season – matching employers with potential employees. Job fairs will be held in Danbury, Manchester, East Hartford and Cromwell.

"Traditionally, our Connecticut Job and Career Fair series – offered each spring and fall – bring employers and jobseekers face-to-face with great results and are regarded by Connecticut businesses as premiere recruitment events for our state," noted Acting Labor Commissioner Dennis Murphy. "Jobseekers will also be able to meet one-on-one with Certified Professional Resume Writers from the Labor Department to have their résumés reviewed and critique, he added.

Employment opportunities range from entry level to management. Employers taking part in the spring Connecticut Career Fairs will have an excellent opportunity to meet a variety of potential candidates possessing professional, technical/high tech, administrative or production skills.

The four career fairs on the spring calendar include:

- The Danbury Career Fair, which will take place Tuesday, March 15 at the Ethan Allen Inn, 21 Lake Avenue Extension in Danbury. Co-sponsored by Cumulus Media and the Danbury Chamber of Commerce, it will run from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. in the hotel’s ballroom.
- The Manchester Career Fair, co-sponsored with Manchester Community College, will take place on Saturday, April 9 at the school, which is located at 60 Bidwell Street, Manchester. To be held in the Great Path Academy Gymnasium, the fair is also co-sponsored by *The Journal Inquirer*, WDRG AM/FM and the MCC Alumni Association.
- The *Heroes 4Hire* Fair – geared for veterans – will take place Tuesday, April 19 at Rentschler Field in East Hartford and runs from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. Aimed at Connecticut residents who have served in the Armed Services, the Connecticut National Guard and the Reserves who are looking for employment, it will be co-sponsored by the Connecticut Veterans’ Administration.
- The Middlesex Career Fair will take place Tuesday, June 21 from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. at the Crowne Plaza in Cromwell. Co-sponsors include the Middlesex Chamber of Commerce and the Workforce Alliance.

There is no fee for jobseekers to attend, and plenty of parking will be available at each site. Attendees are urged to bring along plenty of résumés and should plan on meeting with every employer to talk about what they can bring to their company.
