Danbury Career Fair Rescheduled to March 10 Due to Possible Inclement Weather

WETHERSFIELD, February 28, 2014 – The Danbury Career Fair originally scheduled for Monday, March 3 at the Ethan Allen Hotel located at 21 Lake Avenue Extension, has been rescheduled to March 10, according to State Labor Commissioner Sharon M. Palmer. The event will run from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.
