



## **CONN-OSHA August 19 Roundtable Discussion Details Commercial Vehicle Safety**

“Any individual involved with commercial vehicle safety needs to be up to date on state and federal laws, such as the size and weight of loads that may be carried, or permits required to operate on our state highways,” noted John Able, CONN-OSHA Occupational Safety Training Specialist and project coordinator for the roundtable series. “Lieutenant Bridge will answer questions and also cover safety belt use, distracted driving, speeding, following too close and general safe driving behaviors.”
