Middlesex County Career Fair Is October 11 at Radisson Hotel Cromwell

WETHERSFIELD, September 25, 2017 – Representatives from more than 40 companies and organizations are expected to take part in the October 11 Middlesex County Career Fair taking place 11 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. at the Radisson Hotel in Cromwell. The event is offered in partnership with the Connecticut Department of Labor, the Middlesex County Chamber of Commerce and Workforce Alliance.

“Jobseekers can meet with potential employers that are hoping to fill possible openings, with positions ranging from entry level positions to management jobs,” said State Labor Commissioner Scott D. Jackson. “The Middlesex County Career Fair traditionally provides an excellent forum for recruiting employees for the skilled workforce employers need, and jobseekers have a great place to meet one-on-one and network with potential employers.”

Companies already signed up to exhibit include FedEx Ground, General Dynamics/Electric Boat, GKN Aerospace, Holo-Krome, New York Life, TOMZ Corporation and Wesleyan University.

There is no charge for parking and admission for jobseekers is free. Employer registration fee is \$300 (\$25 additional if an electrical outlet is needed) and includes a boxed lunch, skirted table, company sign, program guide listing and extensive radio, newspaper and Internet advertising.
