(HARTFORD, CT) – Governor Dannel P. Malloy and Lt. Governor Nancy Wyman released the following statements regarding the passing of Patricia Low, Chair of the State Board of Labor Relations. She served the board for 40 years, having been first appointed by Ella Grasso in 1977.

She led a life of firsts – first woman to serve as Chair of the State Board of Labor Relations, and first woman Chair of her local Democratic Town Committee, to name a few.
