WETHERSFIELD, June 15, 2018 – The Connecticut Department of Labor is offering jobseekers in Eastern Connecticut an additional resource in their search for that new position this summer – several opportunities to meet with area companies to discuss possible employment.

The summer-long series of “Micro Career Fairs” (also known as “Employer Wednesdays”) is hosting local employers at the state’s new *Montville American Job Center* from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. every other Wednesday to review résumés and meet with job candidates. The *Montville American Job Center* is located at 601 Norwich-New London Turnpike Suite 1, Uncasville.
