

Aquiline Drones Corporation Employees Eligible To Apply For Trade Act Benefits

WETHERSFIELD – The Connecticut Department of Labor has certified former employees of Aquiline Drones Corporation as eligible to apply for federal Trade Adjustment Assistance. The Hartford facility employees, who manufactured drones, were certified on November 29, 2021.

All affected employees will receive an eligibility notice by mail that explains how to apply for benefits. Employees eligible to apply for federal benefits are those who are or will be totally or partially separated from employment due to lack of work on or after November 3, 2020, and on or before November 29, 2023.

Available assistance may include training; income support in the form of Trade Readjustment Allowances; and job search and relocation allowances for qualified workers who seek or obtain employment outside their normal commuting areas.
