



Labor Department, MCC Partner with Community to Offer 13th Annual Job/Career Fair April 9

WETHERSFIELD, March 17, 2011 – Manchester Community College is the site of an April 9 job fair being held as part of the Connecticut Department of Labor’s spring series. Taking place from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. in the college’s Great Path Academy Gymnasium, the event is co-sponsored by Manchester Community College, *The Journal Inquirer*, WDRC AM/FM, and the MCC Alumni Association.

“This is the agency’s 13th year of bringing together area employers with jobseekers and the Manchester job fair has become a tradition not only for us, but for the community as well,” noted Labor Department Commissioner Glenn Marshall. “Individuals will be able to meet face-to-face with companies offering positions in the technical, management, medical, manufacturing, and sales fields. With more than 1,500 individuals expected to attend, employers have the opportunity to connect with hundreds of prospective job candidates and streamline their recruitment efforts.”

Jobseekers attending the Saturday career fair will also be able to meet with Certified Professional Résumé Writers from the Connecticut Department of Labor who will be onsite throughout the event to review and critique résumés to help ensure that they fully showcase an applicant’s skills and accomplishments.

Admission to the Manchester Community College Job Fair is free, and parking is plentiful in the school’s lot. Those planning to attend should bring plenty of résumés, dress to impress, and be ready to meet one-on-one with prospective employers.
