

HONEYWELL BUILDING TECHNOLOGIES EMPLOYEES ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR TRADE ACT BENEFITS

WETHERSFIELD, CT – The Connecticut Department of Labor has certified former employees of Honeywell Building Enterprises as eligible to apply for federal Trade Adjustment Assistance. The Northford facility employees, who produced and distributed fire alarm systems, were certified on September 30, 2021.

All affected employees will receive an eligibility notice by mail that explains how to apply for benefits. Employees eligible to apply for federal benefits are those who are or will be totally or partially separated from employment due to lack of work on or after August 3, 2020, and on or before September 30, 2023.

Available assistance may include training; income support in the form of Trade Readjustment Allowances and job search and relocation allowances for qualified workers who seek or obtain employment outside their normal commuting areas.
