**BOARD MEETING
September 18, 2008**

MINUTES

Present: John W. Moore, Jr.; Patricia V. Low; Wendella A Battey; and Jaye Bailey

The meeting was called to order by John W. Moore, Jr., Chairman, at 9:32 a.m.

I. ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES

Upon a motion duly made by Wendella A. Battey and seconded by Patricia V. Low, the Board unanimously

VOTED to accept the Minutes of the August 21, 2008 Board Meeting as presented.

II. GENERAL COUNSEL REPORT

- a.) **Scheduling** - Jaye Bailey reported that two cases need deliberation dates. The Board decided to deliberate A & R, SUPP-26,896 on 9/22/08 at noon. Bridgeport, MPP-25,800 et al will be deliberated on 10/9/08 at 9:30 am.
- b.) **Review of Records** - Jaye Bailey reported that records are scheduled to come in during the remainder of September and October 2008. Attorney Alex Gross argued the Donna Bligh appeal in court on September 16, 2008. The argument went very well, with the Judges asking many questions. The panel requested supplemental briefs from the parties on the issue of final judgment. The Region 16 appeal will be argued on October 3, 2008 in Superior Court. Attorney Bailey will attend a pre-trial regarding the State Police appeal, also scheduled for October 3, 2008.

III. AGENT'S REPORT

- a.) **Statistics** - Jaye Bailey reported the following on behalf of Agent Katherine Foley: 112 cases have been filed since the start of the fiscal year; 120 cases have been closed and 281 remain open. The numbers represent a slight downturn in cases since last year.

IV. OTHER BUSINESS

- a.) **Budget** - Jaye Bailey reported that the Governor's Office has requested agencies to prepare a 10% reduction contingency plan . Further details about the budget will be forthcoming.
