MINUTES

BOARD MEETING

February 19, 2014
9:30 a.m.

Present: Patricia V. Low, Chairman, Wendella Ault Battey, Barbara J. Collins and Harry B. Elliott, Jr.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Low at 9:35 a.m.

I. ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES

Upon a motion duly made by Barbara J. Collins and seconded by Wendella Ault Battey, the Board unanimously

VOTED to accept the Minutes of the January 22, 2014 Board Meeting as presented.

II. GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

- a) **Decisions** – Attorney Elliott reported that since the last Board meeting on January 22, 2014, one (1) decision has been issued – Bridgeport (#4602-A). He stated that four (4) records are pending: three (3) are due in February (UCONN – SPP-29,836, Bristol – MPP-35,547, MDR-30,571 and Middlebury - MPP-30,117) and one (1) in March (Bristol Board of Education – MPP-30,383)
- b) **Litigation Update** – Attorney Elliott reported on the following cases on appeal: **New Haven v. Local Local 3144** –the briefs have been filed and a Hearing is scheduled for March 11. **Poquonnock v. SBLR**, the Labor Board filed an Opposition on Town's Motion to Intervene which is still pending and a Hearing is scheduled for March 20. **Norwalk v. SBLR** – The Union's brief has been filed recently and the Labor Board's brief is due in Appellate court on March 17. **Hartford v. SBLR** was argued before Judge Prescott on February 11, 2014.

III. AGENT'S REPORT

Agent Katherine C. Foley was absent due to other business.

IV. CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

Chairman Low reviewed the present calendar and has rearranged the deliberation schedule for the month of March to accommodate our Board members who will be away during the next few weeks.

Chairman Low stated that we are still in need for certified transcripts from the court reporter, noting the two Piteau hearings scheduled in March. Attempts to contact court reporter for signature has been unsuccessful.

There was discussion on the digital filing of briefs by the parties and the Board has decided to mention this policy at the end of the hearings as a present reminder at this time.

V. ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the meeting, a motion was duly made by Wendella Ault Battey, seconded by Barbara J. Collins, and it was unanimously

VOTED to adjourn the meeting.
