The meeting was called to order by Patricia Low at 10:40 a.m.

I. ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES

Upon a motion duly made by Barbara Collins and seconded by Patricia Low, the Board unanimously

VOTED to accept the Minutes of the October 27, 2015 Board Meeting as presented.

II. GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

- a) **Decisions** – Attorney Elliott reported that since the last Board meeting (10/27/15) one (1) decision has been issued: New Haven Dec. No. 4847.
- b) **Records Pending:** Attorney Elliott reported that there are (4) records pending for the month of December: State (SPP-31112), State (SPP-31223), New Haven (MPP-31241) & New London (MPP-31314). There are two (2) records pending for the month of January: Hartford Board of Education & Piteau (MPP-29195) & Bridgeport (MPP-30177).
- c) **Litigation Update** – Attorney Elliott reported on the following cases on appeal: **Bristol Board of Education** – with Appellate Court and awaiting oral arguments. **Stamford Career Firefighters (Berg)** – Company's brief was due 12/28/15 and was extended to 2/1/16. SBLR's brief is due 3/1/16. **Oxford Board of Education** – Judge Schuman dismissed Oxford School Board's appeal 11/20/15. Appeal, if any is due 11/30/15. **New Haven (Briscoe)** – Referred to Judge Magistrate for settlement discussion. Conference scheduled for 12/16/15 in USDC at 10 a.m. **SBLR v. Blumenthal** – Withdrawn on 10/28/15.
