August 31, 2015

The meeting was called to order by Patricia Low at 11 :20 a.m.

I. ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES

Upon a motion duly made by Wendella Battey and seconded by Patricia V. Low, the Board unanimously

VOTED to accept the Minutes of the July 28, 2015 Board Meeting as presented.

II. GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

- a) Decisions - Attorney Elliott reported that since the last Board meeting four (4) decisions have been issued: Ridgefield Dec. No. 4830; Stamford Dec. No. 4832; State Dec. No. 4833 & Ansonia Dec. No. 4836.
- b) Records Pending: Attorney Elliott reported that there are two (2) records pending for the month of September: Hartford - MPP-30924 - 10/02/15 & New Haven (Council 4) - MPP-31285 - 08/31/15.
- c) Litigation Update - Attorney Elliott reported on the following cases on appeal: Bristol Board of Education - SBLR brief filed with appellate 8/17/15; Union brief filed 10/5/15; Board of Education reply expected by 11/5/15. Stamford Career Firefighters (Berg) - Pre-argument on 10/16/15; Counsel's brief due 12/28/15; SBLR & Berg's briefs due 1/27/16. 0  
New Haven (Briscoe) - Case removed to Federal Court- awaiting argument on Motion to Remand. SBLR v. Blumenthal - still pending, awaiting conclusion of Piteau matter.

III. AGENT'S REPORT

Agent Foley reported that there are two petitions left to hear - informal is scheduled for Wednesday.

Agent Foley said that she is still working on getting help but she thinks the process is being held up by the pending layoffs.

West Haven/UPSEU/Council 15 - Incumbent union has filed an objection.

Agent Foley stated that we are up 38 cases from last year.
