The meeting was called to order by Wendella Battey at 10:30 a.m.

**I. ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES**

Upon a motion duly made by Barbara Collins and seconded by Wendella Battey, the Board unanimously

**VOTED** to accept the Minutes of the June 28, 2016 Board Meeting as presented.

**II. GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT**

- a) **Decisions** – Attorney Elliott reported that since the last Board meeting (6/28/16) four (4) decisions have been issued.
- b) **Records Pending** – There is one record pending in July and four records pending in August.
- c) **Litigation Update – Bristol Board of Education** – No petition for certification filed – closed; **Stamford (Berg)** – Complainant seeking enforcement proceedings against Union; **Bridgeport (Vivo)** – City/Union's briefs filed 7/15/16. Labor Board's brief due 9/19/16; **Mosby** – pretrial conference scheduled for 7/28/16 but Atty. Gagne asked for continuance – scheduling conflict – proposing reschedule to 8/11/16.
- d) **Conferences** – N.E. CLRA – Renegotiated with UMass Amherst - lower rate than Wachusett – possible training in April 2017 (4/6 – 4/7 or 4/20 – 4/21).

**III. AGENT'S REPORT**

Kathy Foley reported that we ended the fiscal year in additional filings over last year. There has been a steady increase over the last three fiscal years. The department is suffering from the absence of both Sondra and Judy but somehow coping with much needed help from Kathy Berube, our sole survivor, who has stepped up to the plate.
