The meeting was called to order by Barbara Collins @ 10:35 a.m.

**I. ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES**

Upon a motion duly made by Wendella Battey, the Board unanimously

**VOTED** to accept the Minutes of the February 26, 2019 Board Meeting as presented.

**II. GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT**

a) **Decisions** – One (1) Decision has been issued since our last Board Meeting of February 26, 2019.

c) **Litigation:**

Hartford (Tree Trimmers) – Court dismissed appeal Wednesday, March 20, 2019. (Appeal due April 9, 2019)

Waterbury (Drug Management) – City's Motion for Stay – oral arguments were March 4, 2019. Court denied Motion – March 15, 2019. Telephone Status Conference scheduled for March 29, 2019.

Middlebury (Police Pension) – Case transferred to New Britain March 13, 2019. Telephone Status Conference scheduled for March 26, 2019

d) **Conferences:**

NECLRA (Consortium) – Albany – June 21, 2019. It was decided that an updated group email list needs to be created and the announcement of the June 21, 2019 Consortium needs to be sent as soon as possible. The list will need to be updated every year.

**III. AGENT'S REPORT**

The Board confirmed Agent's Order of Election for Bloomfield – Case No. ME-33550 – Amended.

diem pay. Kathy Foley answered that she will contact Heidi Lane to see if there is time to have such a bill submitted.
