MINUTES

November 26, 2019

The meeting was called to order by Wendella Battey @ 10:45 a.m.

I. ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES

Wendella moved and Barbara seconded confirmation of approval of the Minutes of the October 29, 2019 Board Meeting.

II. ASSISTANT GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

- a) **Decisions** – Three (3) decisions have been issued since our last Board Meeting of October 29, 2019.

DCF (Dale King) – Defendant's brief due January 6, 2020.

SCRWA – Employer filed reply brief on November 13, 2019. Oral arguments scheduled for December 9, 2019.

Wendella Battey asked that decisions be issued in less time than they have been.

Shelton & Shelton Police – MPP-33574 will be deliberated on Thursday, December 5, 2019 at 10:30 a.m.

III. AGENT'S REPORT – Filings are down. From July 1, 2019 to November 15, 2019, 212 cases were filed. From July 1, 2019 to November 25, 2019, 160 cases were filed (down 52 cases).

There might be more cases next year when newly appointed selectmen, etc. take office.

Even though there are fewer cases, the Board seems to be spending more time on each case.

Kathy Berube will retire on February 1, 2020. Liz Dunn has returned from eye surgery and is doing well.

The SBLR Christmas party is scheduled for December 19, 2020.
