MINUTES

August 27, 2019

Present: Wendella A. Battey, Barbara Collins, Katherine Foley, Harry Elliott & Judy Englehart

The meeting was called to order by Wendella Battey @ 10:35 a.m.

I. ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES

Wendella moved and Barbara seconded confirmation of approval of the Minutes of the July 30, 2019 Board Meeting.

II. GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

- a) **Decisions** – Three (3) decisions have been issued since our last Board Meeting of July 30, 2019.
- b) **Records Pending:**
There are two (2) records pending for September and one (1) record pending for October.
- c) **Litigation:**
 - Middlebury – Oral arguments on merits before Judge Frazzini who ordered supplemental briefs on past practice – due September 11, 2019.
 - Stephanie Wilson – Plaintiff's briefs due August 30, 2019; Defendant's briefs due September 30, 2019. On August 2, 2019, Plaintiff filed motion to strike our answer because her complaint is "procedurally defective and legally insufficient. Attorney Elliott filed objection and court sustained objection.
 - Joan O'Rourke – All briefs filed, oral arguments scheduled for September 10, 2019.
 - DCF (Dale King) – Plaintiff's brief due September 23, 2019; Defendant's brief due October 23, 2019 and reply due November 11, 2019.
 - SCRWA – Oral arguments for Motion for Stay on August 26, 2019 – denied by Judge Huddleston. Record filed August 26, 2019; Plaintiff's brief due September 30, 2019; Defendant's brief due October 30, 2019 and Plaintiff's reply due November 13, 2019.
 - Waterbury (prescription drug case) - Briefs are in, oral arguments scheduled for September 24, 2019.

- III. **AGENT'S REPORT** – Kathy Foley was very happy to announce that Doug Cho has accepted the position of Assistant Agent. The feedback both internally and in the field has been very positive. Agent Foley feels that Doug is a very qualified and welcome addition to the Labor Board.

Agent Foley stated that work is steady in the department and there was an increase in filings for this past fiscal year.
