The meeting was called to order by Wendella Battey @ 10:35 a.m.

**I. ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES**

Barbara moved and Wendella seconded confirmation of approval of the Minutes of the April 11, 2019 Board Meeting.

**II. GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT**

**a) Decisions** – Six (6) Decisions have been issued since our last Board Meeting of April 11, 2019.

Joan O'Rourke – O'Rourke's brief due June 3, 2019, Board's brief due July 15, 2019 and O'Rourke's reply brief due August 15, 2019.

**III. AGENT'S REPORT**

Kathy Foley reported that a meeting was held last week regarding our printers which will be removed by August 2019 and replaced with a main printer shared by all. A key will be required which may make it difficult for the Board when they are seeking copies from the hearing room.
