Re: *Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act – Extension Notice*

Dear Sir/Madam:

On October 2, 2019, we announced that DF Opco LLC (“Dari Farms”) expected to permanently close the Tolland distribution center (55 Gerber Drive, Tolland, CT 06084) on October 18, 2019, and that we expected the first employee separations to occur on October 2, 2019. On October 16, 2019, we extended the Tolland distribution center’s anticipated closure date to November 8, 2019 and stated that we anticipated remaining separations from Dari Farms would occur between October 28, 2019 and November 8, 2019. Subsequently, on November 8, 2019, we extended the Tolland distribution center’s anticipated closure date to November 22, 2019 and stated that we anticipated remaining separations from Dari Farms would occur between November 11, 2019 and November 22, 2019. The Tolland distribution center’s anticipated closure date was again extended on November 21, 2019 to an anticipated closure date of December 21, 2019, with remaining separations from Dari Farms to occur between November 23, 2019 and December 7, 2019. Once again on December 7, 2019 the closure date was extended to December 21, 2019, with remaining separations from Dari Farms to occur between December 8, 2019 and December 21, 2019.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the anticipated separation date of your employment has been extended again to allow sufficient time to close the Tolland distribution center operations. Currently, we expect the Tolland distribution center to close on January 4, 2020. We now anticipate that employees will be separated from Dari Farms between December 22, 2019 and January 4, 2020.
