



Volunteers needed for research

Workers experiencing low back pain, hand pain, neck pain, injury or any other musculoskeletal condition that may limit the ability to work normally or return to work, may qualify for the study.

The purpose of the study is to evaluate whether having the assistance of a RETAIN-CT work navigator team helps improve health, reduce future work absense or disability for workers with musculoskeletal injury, pain or illness.

Study eligibility: 18-65 years old, currently employed or self-employed with a musculoskeletal diagnosis that limits the ability to work normally or return to work.

Participation requests volunteers to:

- Enroll and complete a 5 minute survey today.
- Agree to work with a RETAIN-CT work navigator if randomly selected (2-4 hours)
- Complete 3 follow-up surveys over next 6 months.

Compensation includes:

\$50 today and after each survey. (\$200 in gift cards over four \$50 installments)
